### Dear readers!

We are pleased to announce the release of the next issue No. 2 2025. (Vol. 7) of the specialized international publication, "Socialization and Human Development" (SHD), in which we constantly publish the results of empirical research, analytical reviews and scientific investigations on current problems of socialization and human development.

We draw your attention to the fact that starting in 2024, the journal issues are recommended for publication by the decision of the Scientific and Technical Council (STC) of the NGO "Ukrainian Association of Psychology of Education and Development", which by agreement includes domestic and foreign psychologists: honorary members and members of the board of the NGO ([www.uaped.com](http://www.uaped.com)).

This issue of the journal presents diverse articles, the authors of which highlight the problems of educational, family and digital socialization, which are important for modern psychological science and social practice, that arise in the processes of functioning of the human psyche at different stages of their ontogenetic development in the conditions of a long-term war, in which Ukraine is involved by a treacherous aggressor.

In particular, the experience of researching the effectiveness of socialization, resocialization and resources of post-traumatic growth of military and paramilitary persons and their family members is summarized in the articles by Kovalevsky and Prokopovych "Resources of post-traumatic growth of veterans", K. Lisna "Risks of professional activity of a family member (Armed Forces of Ukraine, Ministry of Internal Affairs, State Emergency Service) as a factor in the manifestation of parental attitudes of spouses and subjective well-being of their children", Dyma and Yordek "Psychotherapy of post-traumatic stress disorder in the military using EMVR: the "Three Yes" protocol".

Genetic features of the relationship between socialization and development are objectified in the materials of Zapeka, Ivanenko "The socialization environment as a factor in the dynamics of emotional states of adolescents and young men in wartime" and Pashchenko and Kanivets "Psychological factors of stress resistance of adolescents and young people in wartime", as well as in the articles of Gorbacheva "The relationship between stress resistance and subjective well-being of Ukrainian students in wartime" and Lyovochkina and Vinnitskaya "Psychological characteristics of the experience of loneliness by women of mature and elderly age".

Theoretical and methodological analysis of the problems of modern educational socialization is presented in the materials of Shvalb and Wernik "Environmentalization as a systemic principle of organizing the educational space of a modern higher education institution" and Yaroshenko and Chugaeva "Theoretical and methodological analysis of modern studies of the motivational sphere of applicants higher education".

In order to expand the scope of possible research into topical issues of modern psychological science and practice, we invite you to familiarize yourself with these and other articles presented in the full issue 2/2025 (Vol.7) of our journal.
